

Capitalization Rules

When we write a good composition, we should pay attention to the capitalization.

Capitalization: - is writing a word with its first letter as a capital letter.

We use capital letter with:-

A) the names of people.

Mona, Ali, Rami,

B) the first letter in a sentence.

Omar is very good at basketball. He has always enjoyed the sport.

C) the pronoun (I).

The pronoun **I** is always written in a capital letter.

I have never missed a day of school and I am going to school tomorrow.

D) the days of the week.

Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

E) the months of the year:

January, February, March,

F) the subjects that we study.

English, Arabic, Math, Science, Social,

G) the names of the countries and the cities.

Jordan, Egypt, England, France, Amman, Cairo, Paris, London,

H) the name of places.

Al Hijaz Schools, Sameh Mall, Jarash, Pyramid,

I) the names of rivers and seas.

The Dead Sea, The Nile River, The Jordan River, The Neva River,

J) the titles of books:

The Snow Queen, The Ugly Duckling, The Little Red Riding Hood, ...
